#### Day 1 Friday - October 6: Depart the USA on your flight to Berlin

Depart the US to Berlin, Germany.

#### Day 2 Saturday - October 7: Arrive Berlin

Welcome to Berlin!

Arrival to Berlin and group transfer to your hotel. At around 2 pm enjoy a walking city tour of the German capital to get an overview of the city.

In the evening enjoy a welcome dinner with your guide and the group.

#### <u>Day 3 Sunday - October 8:</u>

Morning guided tour provides an overview of historic and contemporary Berlin and includes numerous famous monuments. Attend worship at the Cathedral of Berlin (P). Afternoon is free to explore nearby Museum Island including the Pergamon Museum, Alte National Galerie, Bode Museum, just to name a few.

#### Day 4 Monday-October 9:

After breakfast continue to the epicenter of the Reformation in Wittenberg. We will visit the largest museum in the world on the history of the Reformation. Also a visit the Schlosskirche in Wittenberg, which houses the tomb of Martin Luther. In the afternoon travel to Dessau for dinner and overnight.

#### Day 5 Tuesday - October 10:

In the morning we travel to Torgau. There we make a photo stop at the war memorial, where Russian and American troops have joined hands at the River Elbe in Germany, bringing the end of the war a step closer.

Afterwards there will be a "Kodak moment" at the Hartenfels castle, where Luther consecrated for the first time a reformed Church, according to his own Ideas. We are going to visit the tomb of Katharina von Bora and make a stop at the building where Luther, Melanchthon, Jonas and Bugenhagen worked out the basic ideas of the Torgau Articles in 1530.

#### <u>Day 6 Wednesday - October 11:</u>

Today there is a sightseeing tour of Leipzig, the city that had a great influence on the economy and spiritual life of Europe for many centuries. The historic architecture of the city center has been beautifully preserved and restored. Visit the St. Thomas Church where Martin Luther preached his ideals of the Protestant Reformation. Along the way to Erfurt we visit

the city of Weimar, home of important figures such as Goethe, Schiller, Bach and Liszt. (B/D) Mercure Hotel.

#### Day 7 Thursday - October 12:

Erfurt is also known as the "Thuringian Rome" due to its architectural beauty. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city and visit the Augustine monastery where Martin Luther served as a monk. Admire the longest wooden bridge in Europe. In the afternoon we visit the city of Eisleben, where Martin Luther was born in 1483.

#### Day 8 Friday - October 13:

Today we visit the impressive castle of Wartburg, where Luther translated the New Testament into German. The castle is also known as Lutherhaus. In the early afternoon travel to Regensburg for overnight. Tonight, enjoy a farewell dinner with your guide and the group.
