

DID YOU KNOW? We're Archiving Our Church History!

Our Church History/Archiving group met for the first time last August in 2018 during the Council All Church Cleaning Day. We have met monthly since then and we're still not finished! When our church relocated to our new church building in Fox Mill in 1998 all history and records that were in the old church parlor/library were packed into cardboard boxes and moved to the new church where they have sat in storage in various locations for 20 years. We have now discarded about half of what we found originally, keeping examples of some things, not all of them, trying to organize materials, store and preserve them safely.

Our church home in downtown St Charles from 1837 to 1998 was at 214 Walnut St. Lazarus House now owns the entire building and is renovating it to hold all of their ministries. We all really need a tour!

We are now at the point of trying to update the written history and would like to keep it up-to-date yearly. A booklet was published in 1937 to celebrate the Centennial Anniversary of the church. For the 150th Anniversary in 1987, a hardbound history book was published. Many copies are still around and available. Several are in the upstairs library if you are interested. In 2017 an updated history of the church was written by Sue Peterson. Rev. Bill Nagy wanted this done while someone was still around who remembered some of the events of the past 40 years and able to write it down. Besides Rev. Bill Nagy, Sue was assisted by Rev. Pat Kitner, Wyonne Hegland, Bob Graham, Mike Linder and Carleen Bart.

We have found many treasures that we want to tell you about in future newsletters, and talk about and show you on Sundays. We feel that our church history is of vital importance, and should be ongoing and up-to-date. What we do as a church family today will be an important part of the church of tomorrow, just as that of yesteryear is to us. Our 200th anniversary is coming in 2037. That's really not so far away.

Zee Zee's Library Update


