Hearing Aids

I recently became aware of a program sponsored by the NIU Audiology Department. They can use hearing aids that you no longer use. There are many children in the surrounding counties that need hearing aids but simply cannot afford them, some as young as 4 or 5 years old. And these appliances are not "adult" or "children" size – they're all the same size. There is a cost of \$200 to fit the kids with a form for their ears, and this has to be done every six months or so as the child grows. Our Church History - Did you Know? Baptism Fonts

Our congregation has used this wooden baptism font since 1949. It was given in memory of Anna Colson. (Long time Fox Valley residents will remember Colson's Department Store located just west of Hotel Baker.) Before that we probably used the silver font pictured below. There is no written information about it that we can find. It's about 8 inches tall. The last baby to be baptized using the silver font was Amanda Nagy, to remember the heritage of our church family. We're interested in finding out more information about it, how long it was used, when was it made, who was baptized using it, etc. If anyone has information please let us know. (Eight sided, hexagonal baptism fonts and baptistries are traditional, remember the eighth day, the first day of resurrection.)
